

2025 Essay Contest

Rules:

The Essay Contest is open to any $5^{th} - 8^{th}$ grade student in Anderson County. Essays are the original work of the individual student and should be 500-750 words in length. Essays may be typed or neatly handwritten on the <u>front side</u> of the paper only. Only legible essays will be considered. Each essay should have the <u>provided cover letter</u> attached to the front, students' names **should not** appear on the essay itself. Each teacher must select <u>ONLY the three best</u> <u>essays</u> in his/her class for judging. If submitting essays from multiple classes of the same grade level, you are allowed to submit the 3 best essays from <u>each</u> class for judging.

Topic Guidelines:

This year's theme highlights the vital role native habitats play in sustaining biodiversity, storing carbon, and protecting soil and water resources. When animals, plants, and aquatic life have healthy habitats, it benefits us all by ensuring ecosystem stability, enhancing natural beauty, supporting clean air and water, and creating a resilient and sustainable environment.



Write an essay that focuses on this topic and helps to explain why habitats have such important roles in sustaining our planet. Be creative with your essay and if you need more resources on the topic, visit the NACD website Stewardship Week - NACD (nacdnet.org)
